

Dear Parents, Guardians and Parishioners


The Christmas excitement does seem to have started as we approach our Christmas Fair, not helped by the arrival of a twenty foot Christmas tree in the school hall!

Times tables

We are working with the children to have a large drive to support our children with having fun with times tables to help our children learn their times tables to 12 by the end of Year 4. We have a new system of rewarding our children for learning their times tables and other number facts.

Have you tried going on www.multiplication.com? This is a good website for reinforcing specific time tables. As a school we have looked at which times tables are the hardest to recall. The table below highlights this clearly the red squares highlighting the tables which children often get wrong. We are targeting specific tables for children to learn as well as the division facts.
