Message from the PTA:

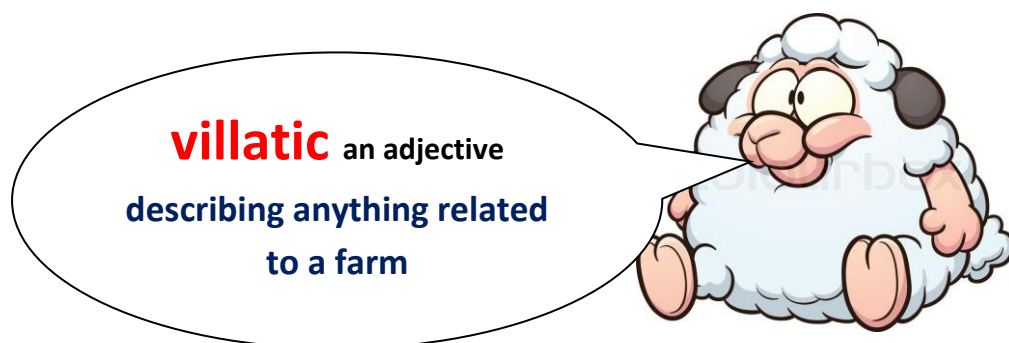
