

Reading Sheets - Year 3-6

We have handed out reading questions recently to support reading and these have been sent on paper today. They are questions that we ask and parents could ask to their children as they read with the children. This is important for all children however easy or difficult they find reading. In particular many confident readers often are encouraged to read by themselves but don't always discuss and explore the books with adults. This often limits their progress as they miss subtleties, inferred meaning and they often skip words they don't understand. This sheet hopefully will help

parents who often ask how they can improve their child's reading. Please explore some of the questions and adapt them depending on the text, continuing to discuss reading together.


