Dear Parents

I am writing to you today to inform you of some temporary changes in the leadership of St Mary's for the next half term. I have recently been in meetings with the Local Authority discussing the possibility of taking on a short term role as an Executive Head of Flookburgh School. The current headteacher of the school, Mrs Pett, is currently absent for medical reasons for the last half term of this academic year. To be approached for this role is in acknowledgement of the good practice taking place at St Mary's School and in my role as a Local Leader of Education (LLE) I am required to share good practice with other schools from time to time.
